How to get Windows 7 to join the domain in Smart-Net 2



Before joining a Windows 7 Professional computer to the domain you must first run the "run-beforejoining-domain-vistaw7w8.reg" registry script. This registry script can be found in the X:\registry\ folder.

Go to the Control Panel and double-click the System icon. Click "Change settings" under the Computer name, domain, and workgroup settings section and then click the "Change" button from the System Properties window that appears.
