

## Setting up Gmail using IMAP in Microsoft Outlook

- 1. Your Google Administrator will need to enable "Allow users to manage their access to less secure apps" under "Less secure apps".
- You will then need to apply settings on your own Google account under "Sign-in & security" and down to "<u>Connected apps & sites</u>". You will need to turn on "Allow less secure apps".
- 3. You will need to enable IMAP in your GMAIL account settings.



4. Open up Outlook and click on File, then click on the drop down for "Account Settings" and then click on the second "Account Settings".



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5. While in the E-mail tab, click on "New" just below. Account Settings

- 6. Click on "Manual Setup or additional server types" and then click "Next".
- 7. Select "POP or IMAP" and click "Next".
- 8. Fill out all fields with the important parts being Account Type needs to be IMAP, User Name field needs to be your full GMAIL email address. Click "More Settings".

9. Under the General tab, you can change the Mail Account name to something more appropriate like "Jane Doe's School GMAIL".



10. Click on the Outgoing Server tab and tick "My Outgoing server (SMTP) required authentication" and select "Use same settings as my incoming mail server".

11. Lastly, click on the "Advanced" tab and change the settings for the "Server Port Numbers". Select SSL for Incoming server (993) and TLS for Outgoing server (587). Click OK.
