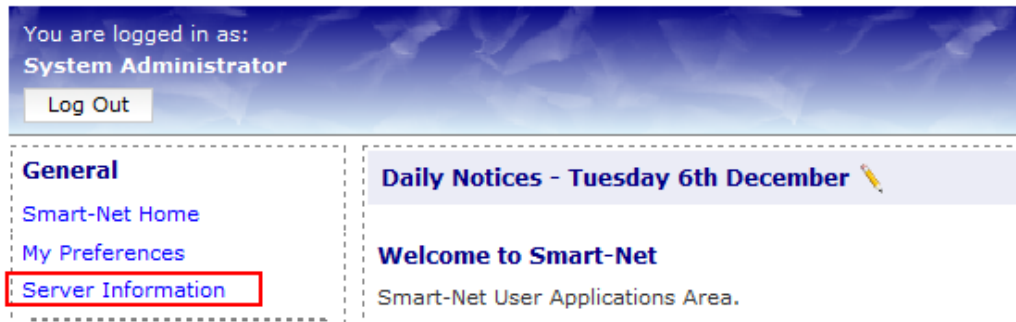


Setting up Proxy on Apple iPad/iPhone/iPod

1. Get the server settings. Login to Smart-Net Intranet and click on “Server Information” on the left.



2. Note down ‘Automatic Proxy Configuration URL’.



3. On Apple device, touch ‘Settings’.
4. Touch Wi-Fi to connect to your schools Wi-Fi connection.



5. Select the wireless name and then enter in the password for the wireless if applicable. Once connected, touch the blue arrow for the chosen wireless connection.



6. Make sure the IP Address is set to DHCP. Scroll down the page, under HTTP Proxy, touch Auto. This will display a URL box which you type in your Automatic Proxy Configuration URL.



7. Get the MAC address of the device. Goto Settings -> General -> About and note the 'Wi-Fi Address' of the device



8. Logon to the Smart-Net Intranet again as an admin account. Goto 'Server Management', 'Firewall Configuration', 'Advanced Configuration' and add the 'MAC address' (from before), with 'Any' as the port and 'Any' as the Destination IP. Give it a good description such as iphone-01. Click Add. Done! Now repeat steps for following devices.

Mac Address Forwarding

Traffic from devices with these Mac Addresses will be forwarded to the specified destination. These rules take precedence over the basic port forwarding.
Hint: You can use 'Any' to match all addresses or ports.

Port Forwarding

Traffic on these ports from the specified source IP to the specified destination IP will be forwarded. These rules take precedence over the basic port forwarding.
